Memo from Dale Eyre of the county about our recorded CCRs.

"To The Cottages Community Association,

We have conducted a preliminary review of the amendments to the Declaration of Covenants, Conditions and Restrictions of the Cottages at Hobble Creek ("CCR") at the request of the Cottages Community Association, Inc. ("HOA"). Utah County has a contractual right to object to any CCR amendments which violate the Maintenance and Open Space Preservation Agreement ("Maintenance Agreement") entered into by HOA and Utah County and by which Utah County has the right to approve or deny CCR modifications. Utah County finds no reason to exercise our contractual right to approve or deny the CCR amendments because no provision of the Maintenance Agreement applicable to Utah County is violated by the CCR amendments. Utah County will make no statement, representation, or determination concerning the legality or effect of the amendments which are private matters between property owners including any amendments which may affect existing ingress, egress, or easement rights.
